KEN TOMPKINS' CAMP BROOKWOOD REPORT: We are now in Week 2 -- a Senior Camp, ages 13-16. First, a general comment: When I consider attendance, it's a night and day difference between last year and this year, with 24 youth registered this week. It's my understanding that we have a weekly capacity of 28 campers and four CITs (Counselors in Training). Next week we will actually be at **full capacity!** This week's theme is CSI (Crime Scene Investigation). Campers participate in a week-long investigation to uncover clues to a crime with new clues revealed each day. **Ray Anderson** (lay-reader, Bairdsville) provides chaplain services to campers and staff this week. The weather continues to be unbelievably amazing and the staff and campers are having a blast! The new swing set is on its way - more on this next week!
