Various good news:

- Vestry has asked the rector to invite Woodstock's vestry to **joint fellowship meeting**
- The rector will convene a **parish "visioning" day** shortly after the November 7th Diocesan Synod
- The **industrial strength swing set** that Holy Trinity has made possible for Camp Brookwood has now reached Florenceville pending the set-up at the camp
- A **Tuesday night Bible study** will begin at the Richmond Parish Centre **next Tuesday, 7pm**. The rector is co-ordinator and one of **Bishop Hockin's** books will be the guide (Monday night's Bible study resumes after Thanksgiving)
- Last Wednesday Holy Trinity joined in the world-wide tintinnabulation **honouring The Queen**
- Last Saturday's **gospel concert** at St John's was largely attended. Another is planned.
- The Diocesan Council, meeting yesterday at Camp Medley, has approved a major **redevelopment of Stone Church** in Saint John.
- **Parish contributions** to the diocese are running at 99% of assessment.

Note the **St Mark's Memorial service** this Sunday afternoon. The rector will preach and **Marjorie Burt Hewson** will be at the keyboard.
