Even those aware that Ernest dabbles in art may be unaware that he is the author of a renowned book on the American Revolution, published by McGill-Queen's University Press. It was an award winner from both the Canadian and the American Historical Associations. All this.. and wonderful oatcakes.

For Camp Brookwood, you would leave money to the Diocesan Synod of Fredericton *for the use of* Camp Brookwood.
