The 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the **consecration of Holy Trinity** approaches on Sunday 3 November. Construction began in 1917 – the date inscribed over the door -- but it took much effort to clear the debt so that Bishop Richardson could set the structure aside “from all profane and common uses” by consecration. Consecration came the week of the great stock market crash of '29.
