This Sunday the **St John's Memorial service** (11 am) and the **St Mark's Memorial service** (3 pm) will take place with social distancing.

Archdeacon Black has given the Vestry notice of retirement, effective 31 December.

Rarely does the parish vestry make life and death decisions but that was on the agenda at the most recent meeting. The vestry has decided to make a substantial contribution to Archbishop Edwards' appeal to fund a **mobile medical clinic in our companion diocese of Ho in Ghana** (see September's NB Anglican). Through the magic of more-than-matching funds from the district Rotary Clubs and hopefully Rotary International, the Richmond contribution will give a big boost to a fund that is already more than half way to its goal. If you want to add your own two mites to the Ho Clinic Appeal (as a number of parishioners have) just mark your envelope accordingly.
