**This Saturday** Rick Robinson leads a **Blessing of the Animals** service on the large green at Holy Trinity, 2 pm. Everyone is invited to bring beloved (and appropriately-vaccinated) pet companions to the service, or an image of the pet or the cremated remains. A financial donation jar will be available in support of the **Carleton County Animal Shelter**. Limited seats are available, so bring your own if feasible.

*Meanwhile*, inside Holy Trinity there will be a **Creatures Great and Small** display of wood carvings, stained glass and paintings in oil or acrylic. They range in date from the 1880s to the present and come from all corners of the parish. Some of the animals depicted in art will also be among those having their ashes blessed in the service.
