St Mark's Cemetery – Through the initiative of **Mac Wilson** and the support of the St Mark's Cemetery Fund, St Mark's cemetery has a **new, granite sign**. This e-news goes to press before the sign was removed from the truck but *the attached photo* shows how beautiful it is. The visible text dates the cemetery to 1930. This is correct. The first burial occurred suddenly in 1930 (accidental death of a child). Later that year William and Lottie McBride deeded the cemetery land and in 1932 Bishop Richardson consecrated it.
