Many people are acquainted with C. S. Lewis's **Mere Christianity** (1952). It is often said to be second only to St Augustine's Confessions as an influential work of Christian apologetics. Less well known is that Lewis took his title from an obscure work by the English puritan **Richard Baxter**. Here is what Baxter wrote in 1680: *I am a CHRISTIAN*, *a MEER CHRISTIAN*, of no other Religion; and the Church that I am of is the Christian Church...: But must you know what Sect or Party I am of? I am against all Sects and dividing parties: But if any will call Meer Christians by the name of a Party...I am of that Party which is so against Parties: If the Name CHRISTIAN be not enough, call me a CATHOLICK CHRISTIAN...as it signifieth one that hath no Religion, but that which by Christ and the Apostles was left to the Catholick Church, or the Body of Jesus Christ on Earth.
