The funeral of the Rev **Dale Alfred Petley** (1958-2022) was held yesterday, being the feast of Sts Peter and Paul, in Moncton. He was the incumbent of Richmond parish, 1985-1989. Most of his active ministry was spent at All Souls, Oklahoma City.

- “His wit was impeccable.”
- “One of the best people I’ve ever known.”
