One of his feats as St Luke's choir director was performance of John Stainer's "The Crucifixion", a Victorian warhorse within the ability of a good parish choir. The oratorio's most beautiful bit is a setting of John 3:16 ("God so loved the world"). Here, from Palm Beach, is a parish choir's rendering of that lovely song from a couple of weeks ago.
