This week the parish received a note of thanks for the latest donation to the **Primate's World Relief and Development Fund**. For 60+ years the PWRDF has worked in more than 30 countries (including Canada) to improve the lives of marginalized people through development programs and relief efforts. As of the end of May, **parishioner special offerings for PWRDF** have totalled over **\$3500**.

Attached to this email is a **parish financial summary** to the end of May. June's figures will include the half-yearly interest on investments.

Also attached to this email is a schedule of **Sunday morning** services for July and August. The return of white daisies in the strawberry fields also signals the return of summer **Wednesday evening** services at St Mark's, beginning 5 July.

Next Thursday's e-News will come from Calgary, where the **General Synod** of the Anglican Church of Canada is meeting. Some of its sessions will be shared with the National Convention of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, which is meeting in the same building. This collect, which was written for yesterday's Indigenous Day of Prayer, also seems apt for the journey together of our two denominations:

Creator God, from you every family in heaven and earth takes its name.
