Saturday (30 September) is the annual day for Truth and Reconciliation, referred to sometimes as Orange Shirt day. It is dedicated to acknowledging the lasting burden of the Canadian Indian residential school system, spanning over a century. The day is a grave occasion to reflect on the systemic injustices faced by Indigenous peoples and to recommit to the path of reconciliation. We may think of residential schools as far from here (Sussex, Shubenacadie), but we might remember that the Anglican parish of Woodstock originated in an effort to "anglicanize" Malecite children, in more than one sense of the term.

Note that this coming Sunday's **parish service** of Morning Prayer is at St Mark's (Jackson Falls), **10 am**.
