- On Good Friday, a day when thoughts should bend eastward to Jerusalem and crucifixion, our minds stray too easily to the cares and pleasures of the moment. That was the situation of the poet **John Donne**, when on a Good Friday he found himself not praying eastward but carried westward on business: and so he gave us "**Good Friday 1613 - Riding Westward**".
