During Advent and Christmas it will accumulate mittens, socks, toques, scarves, etc, after which the knitwear goes to a local school for children this winter. All are invited to donate. Some parishioners are already knitting up a storm for this worthy cause.

This coming Sunday there is also a final opportunity to contribute to one of the **blue Seafarers' Mission boxes** in the churches. They solicit donations for seafarers from distant parts who arrive at the **port of Saint John**. Donations must be *unwrapped*. With each box is a list of suggestions, such as toiletries, warm items (esp gloves, scarves), playing cards, game books, individually-wrapped candy. Financial donations are also accepted. Bev from the Mission is amazed each year that our landlocked parish supports this **outreach to welcome strangers** to NB.

The annual Small Works show of fairly inexpensive items suitable for seasonal giving is on at the **McCain Gallery**, **Florenceville**. Work by at least two parishioners is on display. Also to be spotted is a charming painting of **Holy Trinity**, though not by a parishioner.

Advent Sunday's parish service was a wonderful occasion. **Canon Williams and all five parish layreaders** took part. **Marilyn Wilson** was recognized as having completed five years in the parish as a server followed by a quarter-century (and counting) as layreader.

Before the dismissal of Sunday's service the wardens read a letter from Archbishop Edwards announcing that the **Rev. Maria Shepherdson** of Upper Kennet in rural England will be licenced in March 2024 as **rector in the parishes of Richmond and Woodstock**. Actual arrival of the new cleric is not quite finalized, depending on immigration, work permit and such like. She and **Philip**, her antipodean spouse, will reside at Richmond Corner.

Her address to her flock last Sunday (see above) notes that she has turned down two earlier opportunities, as not feeling called. To **Richmond and Woodstock she feels a call**. Are we, too, called?
