Our energetic and beloved primate, **Archbishop Linda Nichols**, **has announced that she will retire** in the fall. Last summer's General Synod voted twice and by a great majority to defer her from mandatory retirement until the meeting of the next General Synod in 2025, but on both occasions the House of Bishops declined to agree by a sufficient margin. In choosing to retire in mid-September rather than on reaching her mandatory date in October, she ensures that the interim primate will be **Ann Germond**, the metropolitan of the ecclesiastical province of Ontario. The other three metropolitan bishops (including Archbishop Edwards) have agreed to this.
