**Lives of the Saints** – two sermons of a Sunday

*8 August 1948:* "Had a Mr Carl Riggs this am [at United Church, Briggs Mill], a student from Kirkland. ... He sang 3 hymns & gave us a good sermon. Spoke of the new Prime Minister [Louis St Laurant] being Catholic etc & that all Protestant churches should unite. Only 9 there – smallest crowd yet. DeWitts & myself, Charlie, Marjorie & Ruthie, & Harold & Albert. ... [G]ot ready & left again before 2:30 &...went right on to the Church... Found it so very dirty where they took the window out yesterday that I tried to sweep up some & got quite a lot of the straw. They have got a good job done on the roof & flu though, & have it all finished. We had 27 this pm & 15 took Comm. MacMillans had Christine baptized, but she got so frightened & cried so hard that they had to go home before Communion. They had Ernest & Margaret McL & Doris stood with them. Mr [Gordon] Smith gave us a splendid sermon on the

Gospel for the 11<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Trinity, Luke 18<sup>th</sup> chapter & 9 verses, & spoke of the Publican & the Pharisee & which of these was the greater. They sang 359 Faith of the Fathers, 253 for the Comm hymn & 389. ... Just had Mabel & Bobby in the choir."
