Yesterday's message from the **Rev Maria Shepherdson**: We have managed a few days of real holiday and a trip of pilgrimage to Canterbury cathedral, where we were prayed for and blessed ahead of coming to you and also joined a Taize service, where we prayed for all of you. See you very soon.

This Sunday afternoon (25 February) the rectory will be open so that folk can deliver remaining loaned or donated items or just look it over.

DV, the **Rev Maria Shepherdson and Philip Shepherdson** will arrive in Fredericton next Thursday 29 February. They will be met by the bishop and Shawn Branch. She will subscribe the oaths of loyalty to the king and obedience to the bishop necessary to receive a licence for ministry. The bishop will licence her with the status of incumbent/rector in both Woodstock and Richmond.

- The rector **will invite lay readers to meet with her** on Saturday 2 March at a time to be announced.
- On Sunday 3 March she will lead a **parish communion service at St John's**, 10 am.

**Update from the Food Bank** Back in January 2023, Volunteer Family Services (aka the Food Bank) was feeding 650 people (one-third of them children). **This January it fed 782**. The Food Bank is always in need of soups, non-sugary cereal, canned beans, canned pasta, dry pasta,

tuna/hamburger helper, vegetables (fresh, frozen, canned), oatmeal, pancake mix, tea, shampoo (men & women), deodorant (men & women), razers (men & women), toothbrushes.

The **Compassion Fund** continues active and it's time for us to consider adding a Compassion Fund donation to weekly offerings. Since September the Fund **has provided assistance in the amount of \$1,200**. This includes a Sobeys gift card and monetary assistance for a person living alone and recovering from surgery; a Sobeys gift card for a mother with young children at Christmas; a Christmas donation and personal hygiene items (much appreciated) for Sanctuary House; and a donation and Superstore gift card for a family in need.
