Sunday Shopping (Woodstock) – The town council of Woodstock – which now includes most of the territory covered by our parish – is considering **ending restrictions on Sunday shopping**, so that any business could operate at any time. (Currently large businesses are restricted to noon til 5 pm.) Last Thursday's Vestry meeting decided to write to the Woodstock town council expressing opposition to the proposed **end to restrictions on Sunday shopping**.

Attached to this E-news is a year-end **parish financial statement for 2023**. Several large, unbudgeted expenses contributed to a loss on the year. The loss would have been much worse but for the annual interest on financial **endowments provided by the wills of deceased parishioners**. When making your own will, consider leaving legacies to the *Corporation of the Anglican Parish of Richmond*.

Also attached to this E-news is a **revised schedule of Sunday services** for February and March. Still to be finalized are arrangements for Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

The **Compassion Fund** continues active and it's time for us to consider adding a Compassion Fund donation to weekly offerings. Since September the Fund **has provided assistance in the amount of \$1,200**. This includes a Sobeys gift card and monetary assistance for a person living alone and recovering from surgery; a Sobeys gift card for a mother with young children at Christmas; a Christmas donation and personal hygiene items (much appreciated) for Sanctuary House; and a donation and Superstore gift card for a family in need.

Again this year **Cheryl Jacobs**, **Bishop Edwards** and a Synod Office crew will be walking in the **Coldest Night of the Year** fundraiser (Saturday 24 February). It is in support of the **John Howard Society**'s work with exoffenders. See <u>PLEASE SPONSOR Anglican Energy (e2rm.com)</u>
