The **New York Times** obituary of the late Pope Benedict has this passage: *In the book 'Introduction to Christianity' (1968) he argued for belief not as a mystical experience but as something inseparable from reason and doubt, taking seriously the element of doubt in the belief of God. He wrote in one celebrated passage, "Just as the believer knows himself to be constantly threatened by unbelief, which he must experience as a continual temptation, so for the unbeliever faith remains a temptation and a threat to his apparently permanently closed world". "In short, there is no escape from the dilemma of being human."*

Or, as Mark 9:24 puts it: "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!".
