Lives of the Saints – sewing for British children (wartime evacuees to Canada)

5 June 1940: "Went to Guild at Mildred McLellan's this afternoon & stitched on Red Cross suits all the afternoon. 22 there." 4 July: "Went to Guild at the Hall this afternoon. First time they have met in the new hall across the bridge. Had 16 for supper counting Ray B, & Stella Briggs was down in the afternoon but went home before supper. ... Had Mr [Howard] Grimmer, Alfred & Stanley to call awhile, & they gave Mr G \$6.00 for wallpaper at the Rectory. Some taking knitting & sewing home. I brought 3 skeins of yarn to wash & a kiddie's pyjama suit to make."
