Lives of the Saints – annual cleaning, June heat 6 June 1934: "Alice & I went over to help clean the church this forenoon & it was awful hot. Just 8 there: Mrs McBride, Alfred & Rettie, Elsie, Kathleen D V, Alice, Stanley G & I. An awful hot day."

12 June 1941: "Went to the store & rang Rettie & waited there till they came & got a ride down to help clean the church. Had 11 ladies & 6 men counting Mr [Howard] Grimmer. They got the posts around the cemetery all painted white while we cleaned the church. Wendell brought me up to the gate shortly after 4 & I was glad because it was hot & I am tired."
