Lives of the Saints - Rogationtide (& fiddleheads)

10 May 1964: "[A]t 15 past 11 Ernest was just going down with the tractor for Church at 11:30. Audrey & family were all down at Freddy's for S[unday] S[chool], & we had the service on the leaflet for Rogation Sunday & the blessing of the seed. ... Mackie was there with his colt when we went outside, & Wilbur had the soil, & Stanley the seeds, & Sandra & Andy the water can. ... We had a good crowd (26) and a lot of

kiddies. Ron & Chriss had Danny & Terry there, & she said Mildred was picking fiddleheads!"
