Circulating with today's e-News is a poster with details of the **Advent study and reflection** opportunities in the Rich/Wood parishes. This 4-week program begins Monday/Tuesday 24-25 November.

This coming Sunday (16 November) is the day when the final **Operation Christmas Child** gifts are **due in the churches**.

One of our standing forms of Christmas outreach is support for the Saint John branch of the Christian **Mission to Seafarers**. The familiar **blue hampers** in each of the churches invites donations of toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, shampoo, razor, shaving cream, deodorant, hand cream), warm clothes (toque, gloves, mittens, scarfs, wool socks,

foot warmers), playing cards, puzzle books, flashlight or headlamp with batteries, Canadian souvenirs like mugs, and snacks.

The Primate's World Relief and Development Fund – now renamed as **Alongside Hope** – offers many ways to show generosity to those in less fortunate parts of the world this Advent/Christmas season. Financial gifts to Alongside Hope may also be made through our weekly offerings, either envelope or e-offering. Donations will be directed to the parish's Operating fund unless the donor directs otherwise. Eligible donations generate a tax receipt early in the new year.

This year's **Advent retreat** as sponsored by the Synod Office will be led by **Stephen Andrews**, a bishop and former principal of Wycliffe College, one of the leading evangelical academies in the Protestant world. He is a polished, thoughtful leader whose decision to retire to NB is a boon to the diocese. This 24-hour retreat on praying the way through Advent runs from **4 pm Friday 5 December to 4 pm Saturday 6 December** at Villa Madonna, Rothesay.
