Parishioners will recall that both our Vestry and some local individuals contributed funds to help establish a **mobile medical clinic** in the west African **diocese of Ho** in Ghana. Last Saturday's meeting of the Diocesan Council heard that it has already helped **several hundred thousand** patients. At the same meeting the Council gave the go-ahead to our Companion Diocese Committee to begin raising funds to help build Ho's **first Anglican high school** to complement its 23 Anglican primary schools. (In Ghana all education is church-sponsored.)

This week's e-News shares photos of three **gorgeous floral offerings** of garden flowers and roadside weeds at Holy Trinity last Sunday. What other little church thanks God through such artistry week by week? Scenes from St Mark's that same day show **Peggy Martin** arriving unexpectedly and in style.
