**There is good news.** As a member of the **Anglican Foundation of Canada**, the parish of Richmond is glad to learn from the following announcement that the Foundation has given **Camp Brookwood** a major grant for much-needed renovation of its refectory building.

*The Anglican Foundation of Canada is pleased to announce a \$12,000 grant to Camp Brookwood in the Diocese of Fredericton to support critical infrastructure upgrades that will ensure a safe and sustainable future for this beloved Anglican summer camp.*

*Last summer, extreme heat forced the camp to close for part of a week – a difficult decision that affected campers, families, and the camp’s already fragile operating budget. This grant will help insulate and upgrade **Howlett Hall** (the main dining and gathering space), install energy-efficient mini-split heat pumps, and improve facilities for staff and campers.*

*For nearly 60 years, Camp Brookwood has provided a simple, faith-filled camping experience for children and youth in rural New Brunswick – with more than half of campers supported through sponsorship in recent years.*

*By strengthening the camp’s infrastructure, this project ensures that young people will continue to experience community, faith formation, and outdoor adventure – even as summer temperatures rise.*
