**There is good news.** Last Saturday morning the kindness of donors, the united labour of volunteers, the generosity of purchasers, and the mercies of God came together at the Parish Centre in an encouraging **yard sale**. The event boosted parish visibility, introduced Parish Centre facilities to many, permitted donors to part with surplus possessions for a good cause, offered bargains to shoppers in need of them, brought together parishioners in a common project, and generated \$1700+ for the **Compassion Fund**.

This week's e-news circulates a few **yard sale** photos. Last Saturday at 7:30 am precisely the calm beauty of St John's church gave way to a parking lot of shoppers bursting into the Parish Centre to commence their strange circling and circling. Accumulating more than \$1700 from \$10 and \$15 transactions meant volunteers really hustled to restock and rearrange. There was no time for chitchat, let alone a moment to sit down. Then, when clean-up morning arrived, a fleet of four trucks in disciplined precision took surplus goods to Library, bookstore, florist shop, food bank and landfill.
